Alternatively, you can rent out furnished spare rooms in shared accommodation elsewhere. This can be a great way to live independently without the expense of renting on your own. This is also a great way to make new friends! Rental properties are advertised on the Real Estate Institute of Western Australia (REIWA) website and in Perth's local newspapers.
